Susan Bennett is best known for her early work on theatre audiences and for her interrogations of Shakespeare in contemporary performance. Other recent publications span topics from Disney theme parks to Ivo van Hove's *Lazarus*. She is currently working on a book about the instrumentalization of performance in support of corporate, city and national brands.
